### MIDLAND MUSINGS

In the first few weeks of the new semester there have been many activities in the science lab. Students in biotechnology/stem class have learned and practiced new skills, such as pipetting and titration. They also had a successful chromatography lab using different concentrations of 2-propanol to separate the pigments into a grape-flavored drink. In physical science, students tested the strength of polymers by adjusting the concentration of gelatin to form cross-links between the protein chains. While studying neurology in anatomy & physiology, students have dissected sheep brains and tested their own tonic and phasic receptors in their hands and arms. And in chemistry, students explored spectroscopy with different metal ions in flame tests.
